

Leadership – your next steps.

A personalised training programme designed to support senior/middle leaders considering moving into headship in our area.

Venue: Newby & Scalby Primary School Scarborough

Cost: £125 Members (£175 Non –Members)

(please note this programme for 2017 has been subsidised through NYCC funding aimed at developing school leaders – the normal cost of this programme is £375 per person)

Focus of the Training

This course provides a personalised professional development programme for middle or senior leaders who are aspiring to headship. Participants will have the opportunity to develop their leadership abilities in conjunction with colleagues and highly effective senior leaders. All areas of school self-evaluation will be considered relating practically to participants' home schools, and authentic leadership tasks will be set, delivered, monitored and evaluated as part of the programme.

Content and Delivery

- Introductory session to include finding out about participants as leaders, an update on latest leadership theory and agreement about the contents of the course
- Tailored twilight sessions meeting the needs of the participants providing opportunities for deep learning through focused analysis of real experiences
- Course manual for each participant including materials that can be modified for use within own school setting
- Authentic leadership of a school improvement priority in agreement with the headteacher of your school
- Individualised coaching and support provided throughout the programme
- Homework will be set after each session with the purpose of encouraging self-reflection and extending learning

Criteria for Participants

- Highly effective teachers who are considering headship at some point in the future
- Reflective practitioners interested in further developing their leadership skills at all levels
- A willingness to engage in creative and interactive sessions designed to engage, motivate and encourage thinking
- A willingness to share experiences with colleagues
- Committed to exploring and testing school improvement techniques
